This race is not a CBYRA sanctioned event, but it is A LOT of fun!

Entry fee \$ 100.00. Due no later than June 10th. Registration opens April 1st. The entry form is attached to this NOR and will be in the invitation mailed to previous years' racers. There is a 100 boat limit. Mail the form and a check made out to "Safety Town" to the address above. Questions should be addressed to the race registrar: Matt Arel, by phone at 309-573-4891 or by email at mmarel@me.com. Email is preferred – thanks! The PBC website: www.portsmouthboatclub.org will have registration and scratch sheet updates, updated sailing instructions, and results. **Classes:** 2022 PHRF of the Chesapeake splits will apply, but may be modified by the number of entrants. There will be monohull racing in Classes A, B, and C, as well as PHRF Non-Spinnaker (single headsail). All boats registering in these classes MUST have a valid 2023 PHRF of the Chesapeake rating no later than June 5th. There will also be a Cruising class, for non-rated boats. If a boat has a valid 2023 PHRF of the Chesapeake rating, it may be assigned as a Cruising racer at the Race Committee's discretion. Cruising Class boats will have a courtesy PHRF rating assigned by the Race Committee and it will not be subject to protest.

Start/Finish: The start/finish line will be on the Southern Branch of the Elizabeth River, just off the Portsmouth Seawall near Tidewater Yacht Marina.

Starting Signals: The starting sequence will commence at 9:00 am EDT, using RRS Rule 26 as modified by the Cock Island Race Sailing Instructions.

Course: The potential courses will be defined in the Cock Island Race Sailing Instructions, which will be published one month prior to the race. These courses will be around marks in the Elizabeth River and Hampton Roads. Actual race course will be announced/displayed at the seawall start/finish line by 08:30 am EDT the morning of the race.

Time Limit: The time limit is 3:00 pm EDT. Any boat not finished by that time will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF). **Protests:** In order to protest, a skipper must comply with RRS Rule 61 and inform the Race Committee at the finish line. Then, the boat must deliver the protest in writing, using RRS format, to the race organizers at the Race Committee tent no later than 4:00 pm EDT on race day. The protest will be heard prior to the awards ceremony.
